About Ängelholm

Ängelholm is a town in the southern part of Sweden that are called Skåne. The city has a population of 41.000. The perfect location close to the sea, forests and hills, enjoying life is easy – every day! The Rönne river floats through the town centre and enters the sea in Skälderviken, adding to the pleasant atmosphere. Six kilometres of sandy beaches, the Kronoskogen forest and the picturesque town centre are other appealing features of Ängelholm.

The town was founded by Danish king Christian II in 1516 and started attracting large numbers of tourists at the beginning of the 20th century, when one of Sweden's first urban summer residential areas – Ängelholm's Havsbad – was planned and built here.

General Information

Public Access

All of the areas are with free access

Consumption of alcohol during the races is not allowed. Smoking is only allowed outside the fence that is surrounding the track.

Food and catering

It will be possible to buy food and other catering on the area both days.

Friday it will be open from 12.00 until 21.00

Saturday it will open 9.00 and won't close until the race end.

We will serve you both hot and cold food, ice cream, snacks and a various kind of drinks. We accept SEK cash, credit cards and Swish.

Water for drinking are available on site.

Toilet and trash containers

There will be toilets on different locations at the area. The same are with the trash containers and please respect the sorting of trash and bottles.

Welcome Center

The welcome Center (Commissaires office) will take place behind our catering stands.

This place is for team manager to pick up number plates per country, transponder rental and we will host the official and team manager meeting here.

MyLaps transponder

All riders in classes, 11 years and older need to have an active transponder, MyLaps ProChip Flex. It's possible to rent a chip for SEK 200. Transponders need to be mounted on your bike, fork, before entering practice on Friday.

Team area

A space incl. tent for teams will be set up in the team park. The tent must be mandatory booking by the fee of:

No refund of the payment will be possible.

Rules

The provisions of the UCI's BMX rulebook in its latest version apply with a few amendments in this Technical guide.

The Nordic championship is registered on the UCI calendar and will be arranged in accordance with the UCI rules for BMX racing. The race is a UCI category C1 for championship riders.

All championship and challenge categories scrambled seeding is used, according to UCI rulebook 6.1.027, 6.1.027bis, 6.1.027quarter, 6.1.029, 6.1.029bis with further explanation refer to UCI rulebook 6.1.033, v20190101.

A and B finals in all challenge classes with final rounds (9 or more riders confirmed)

The number of heats during the motos and the number of riders in each such heat shall be determined as per Annex 1, based upon the number of riders entered and confirmed in the category following rider confirmation.

Likewise, the number of riders who will transfer from the motos into the qualifiers or the final (whichever the case may be), will be full gate. However, the riders are randomly distributed through these heats, such that the heats are not the same within each of the three rounds of the motos UCI rulebook 6.1.027quarter.

For more explanation of the scrambled moto and transfer system please refer to UCI rulebook 6.1.033.

To avoid any doubt, during motos, random predetermined gates, time in 3rd moto and in qualifiers determines lane selection for the next round, refer to UCI rulebook 6.1.029bis.

In categories with 5-8 riders, the rider with the highest total points earned in the motos will not be transferred to the final.

Schedule of races and transfer systems for all challenge categories:

Riders	Moto/heats	¼ finals	½ finals	Finals
<8	1	-	-	Drop 1 rider
9-16	2	-	-	A final of 8 riders, B final with minimum 2 riders
17-24	3	-	2x8 riders	A and B finals of 8 riders each
25-32	4	-	2x8 riders	A and B finals of 8 riders each
33-40	5	4x8 riders	2x8 riders	A and B finals of 8 riders each
41-64	6-8	4x8 riders	2x8 riders	A and B finals of 8 riders each

When the Nordic championship is arranged in Norway and Sweden, there will be no finals for the riders 10 years and under. 4th heat in all categories, scramble seeding is used for all motos and random seeding.

On tracks with SX starting gates, the 8 meter starting hill together with pro sections will be used for junior and elite classes. If the junior and elite classes are combined with a challenge class, the 5 meter starting hill shall be used and the pro sections shall not be used.

In case of special conditions (weather etc) the organiser allows PCP to reduce the numbers of motos. This can only apply for challenge classes and never for championship classes.

Equipment:

The use of interlocking pedal-cleat system is allowed for category 13 years and over according to article 6.1.079, v20190101.

All riders must have either a national flag of their country on both their shoulder or a national jersey of their country. Name printed back are allowed but not any number at their jersey.

The race jersey need to be wear during prize ceremony.

Nordic championship classes

Championship classes:

Junior men: 17-18 years

Junior women: 17-18 years

Elite men: 19 years and over

Elite women: 19 years and over

Junior and elite classes can be combined for the race, and the results will be split into the original classes.

Challenge classes:

Boys: 6 years and under, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 years and over

Girls: 7 years and under, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 years and over.

Cruisers men: 17-29, 30-39, 40+

Cruiser women: 17+, 30+

There must be minimum of 5 riders entered to the championship classes and 3 riders entered to the challenge classes in the competition to open a class.

If there are less than 5 riders registered for category elite and junior women, they will be combined with women 17+ for the race, and the results will be split into the original classes.

If there are less than 5 riders registered for the category elite and junior men, they will be combined with men 17+ for the race, and the results will be split into the original classes.

After end registration following classes will be combined for the race, and the results will then be split in the original classes:

- Boys 6 years and 7 years
- Girls 7 years and 8 years
- Girls 9 years and 10 years
- Girls 11 years and 12 years
- Cruiser Women 17+ and 30+
- Cruiser 30-39 years and 40+

Riders eligible to enter the Nordic championship

Junior and elite:

Riders from a Nordic or Baltic country (Norway, Sweden, Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Latvia, Estonia and Lithuania), who is a citizen in a Nordic or Baltic country and holds a license from a Nordic or Baltic federation, can enter the Nordic championship.

Riders from another country can enter the race, but will not be eligible for the championship title. If a rider from a non Nordic or Baltic country enters the race, there shall be two prize ceremonies. One ceremony for the Nordic championship where the non Nordic riders are not included, and one ceremony for the total result of the race.

Challenge:

Riders who are either a citizen in a Nordic or Baltic country, or holds a license from a Nordic or Baltic federation, can enter the Nordic championship.

For avoidance of doubt, all riders entered in the Nordic Championship and challenge games must have a license issued by the national federation of their country of residence. The national federation of each such rider's nationality has the duty to confirm this prior to registration.

Registration:

According to The Nordic Bmx committee the registration fee 2019 are:

Elite men and women: 60 €

Junior men and women: 40 €

Challenge classes: 30 €

Registration date is set to 1th of July.

Registration for Challenge riders after deadline can't be accepted.

Late registration, only for elite, is double fee and can be accepted until Friday 2nd of August (12.00-14:30) in cash only.

Registration and registration fee shall be forwarded to the organizing club through the national federations. The registration fees for all riders per National Nordic federations must be paid no later than **4th of July**.

There are no limits to the number of riders entered into the competition.

Number plates and seeding:

EBMX will provide number plates, side plates and start numbers for the riders. The rider shall use the front and side plate that are provided. A rider who fails to display the correct number plate and side plate will be refused their start, or relegated, if it's noticed after beginning of heat or run.

Seeding for the champion and challenge classes is from the results from the previous year. The numbers 1-8 is allocated to riders according to the results from the previous year. If a rider enters a higher age class, they will be allocated the numbers 11-18. If a rider with nr 1-18 is not registered, the number shall not be used. Number 21 and up is distributed to the remaining riders.

21-40 riders from Sweden

41-60 riders from Finland

61-80 riders from Norway

81-100 riders from Denmark

101-120 riders from the Baltic country.

An elite class rider with a career number shall use their career numbers assigned by the UCI.

Accreditation information

Accreditation before the Nordic Championship for team managers and assistants is not necessary. However, each federation which register riders must appoint a Chef d'Equipe (National team manager) to represent the interest of all its riders. Each National team manager must confirm the presence of each rider as per the preregistration riders list, on scheduled day and times of registration.

Team managers and assistants need to present a licens from the federations at registration, furthermore sign in at the commissaries center. A necklace and card will be provided for team managers and assistants. It's expected the team manager and the assistants are well known with the UCI rulebook in general and this Technical guide in specific.

The maximum number of assistants is based on the number of attending riders.

Team managers should participate at the Team manager meeting.

Team managers and assistants are both allowed to enter the track in case of accident/crash.

Officials:

There will be 2 officials at the finish line as a back up to the timekeeping and photo finish at the finish line. Each country provides one official for the race.

Awards:

Junior and elite:

For each class there will be 3 medals, gold, silver and bronze. The winner will have a bouquet of flowers. The medals will be the Nordic championship medals from the Nordic Cycling federation. The medals are engraved with the year and class.

There will be prize money in the championship competition for the best 8 junior and elite riders according to the UCI BMX financial obligations. Riders, place 1-8, are obliged to attend the award ceremony.

The prizemoney for 2019 is:

Place	Junior women and men	Elit women and men
1	350 Euro	800 Euro
2	175 Euro	400 Euro
3	125 Euro	200 Euro
4	75 Euro	175 Euro
5	50 Euro	150 Euro
6	40 Euro	125 Euro
7	30 Euro	100 Euro
8	20 Euro	75 Euro

For all categories it's mandatory to wear minimum BMX jersey, for Championship prize ceremony according to the UCI Rulebook.

Challenge:

All the 8 finalists will have an award engraved with Nordic championship 2019, class and place 1-8. In classes with only 8 riders or less there will only be 3 awards for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.

When the competition is arranged in Sweden, there will be awards for all riders who are 10 years and younger.

Nations competition:

At the Nordic championship there will be a Nation competition. The Nation competition is open for the Nordic or Baltic countries and includes riders from classes 13 years and over. Points are awarded in the finals as follows:

Place	Points
1	4
2	3
3	2
4	1

There is only awarded points for one rider from each country in the same final heat:

(Example)

Place	Riders from Country	Points
1	Sweden	4
2	Sweden	0
3	Norway	3
4	Sweden	0
5	Finland	2
6	Denmark	1
7	Norway	0
8	Denmark	0

If there are only two nations in the final, the points are reduced as follows:

2 points for 1. place and 1 point for 2. place

If there is only one nation in the finals there is only awarded 1 point.

The winner of the Nations competition is the nations with the highest points. If two nations have the same score, the results are decided as follows:

The nation with the highest number of 1st places wins, then 2nd places etc. If the winner still cannot be decided, the last complete final determines the winner.

The winning nation will receive a Trophy as winner of the National competition.
